TASTING NOTES

A barrel fermented chardonnay that came from our vineyard planted in 1986 that is now 30 years old. It has always produced rich layered Chardonnay's that have plenty of fruit to balance the oak.

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS

Works equally well with pork, chicken or seafood. The perfect oak chardonnay to accompany food!

VINTAGE CHARACTERISTICS

A warm vintage for Chardonnay that develops the higher fruit notes.

WINEMAKING METHODS

Barrel Fermented primary and 100% ML secondary in a mix of cooperages to frame the fruit.
